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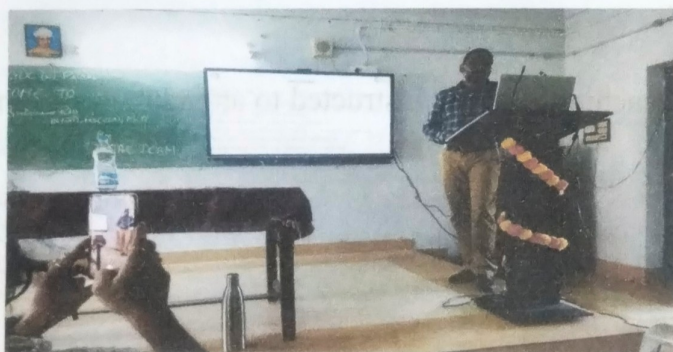

Orienting the faculty to the redesigned NAAC Accreditation framework and teaching them how to effectively highlight departmental activities that lead the institution's accreditation process.

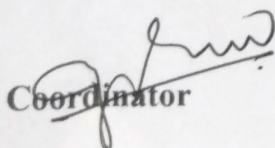
Description

Description

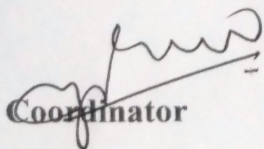

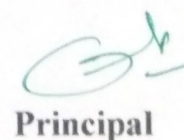
The workshop also provided valuable insights into maintaining a work-life balance and developing resilience in the face of challenges often encountered in research careers.

Objective

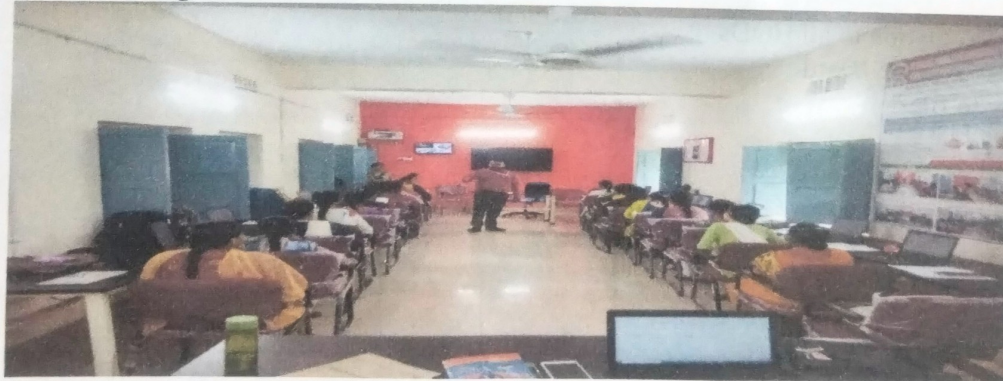
The objective of this initiative is to promote collaborative research between the lecturers and to enhance academic research quality and foster knowledge exchange through joint research projects and academic activities.

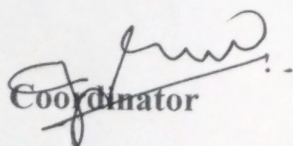

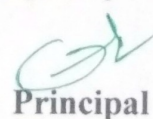

- A revised assessment framework focusing on student outcomes and engagement.

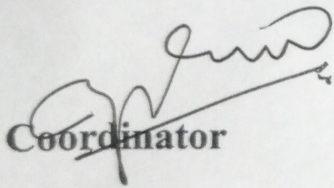

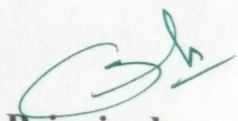
Participants actively engaged in a group discussion to explore strategies to enhance the college's readiness for NAAC accreditation under the new system.

REPORT ON STUDENT INDUCTION PROGRAMME 2023-24

On 8-8-2023 SIP- Student Induction Programme was inaugurated by the Principal. Sri C Ravi sanker, Lec.in. Commerce and Vice Principal after conducting ice breaking session - explained the rules and regulations to be followed in the college in his ppt. He emphasized the need of discipline keeping in view of NAAC re accreditation during September 2023. He directed the students to approach for any issue/problem first to Mentor then to HOD OR vice principal, then only they are suppose to meet the Principal. He informed that FOR all bus passes/bus pass related student STUDY certificates to approach vice principal. For evening permissions to Principal madam , if she is not available in the campus, vice principal. He informed that canteen is available for students and other infrastructure available in the campus for the students in detail.

On 9-08-2023 Dr.P.V Ramana, Lec.in. Physics explained the curricular and co curricular activities undertaken by the college during this academic year. He explained the single major curricula pattern and credits and hours for each paper in detail for first year students and intersnship of 2/4/6 months.

On 10.8.2023 Smt.MLD Sirishna, JKC mentor explained the college offering employable skill opportunities in the college (JKC an APSSDC) and motivated the girl students, to be sharp by the end of final year to get placement in the campus drives conducted by the institution.

On 11.8.2023 Smt V Sirisha, Lec.in. Botany and CCE LMS portal available in the site. She explained that the LMS is in revamping by the CCE and stated that she will take another classes in due course in this regard

On 14-8-2023 Smt K M Mahalakshmi, Lec.in.Economics explained about NEP 2020 and credits pattern in single major subject and life skill/skill development courses in her ppt presentation.

On 16.8.2023 Dr.A.Satyanrayana, Lec.in.Maths , and Academic Co.Ordinator addressed the first year students regarding CSP(Community Service Project - 2 months and 2 months short term internship and long term internship for 6 months to be completed by a graduage students during the course. 12-12-2023

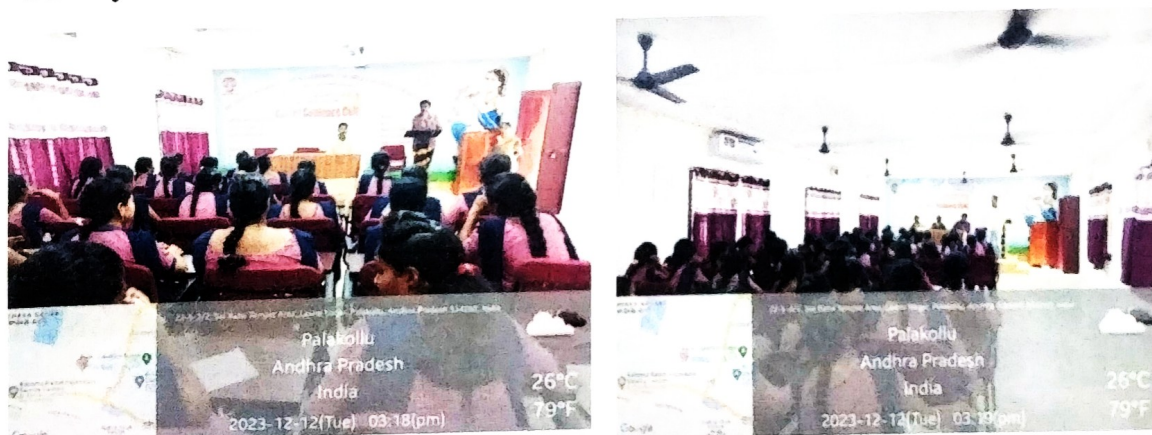
Objective:-

Students learnt how to develop and build their career by choosing the right way. They understand how to prepare for competitive exams and other PG exams after completion of UG course.


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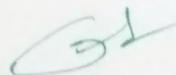
