- With an intention of bridging the gap between academics and industry and train our students in the weak areas, the JKCs in Government Degree Colleges have evolved into a useful training platform.

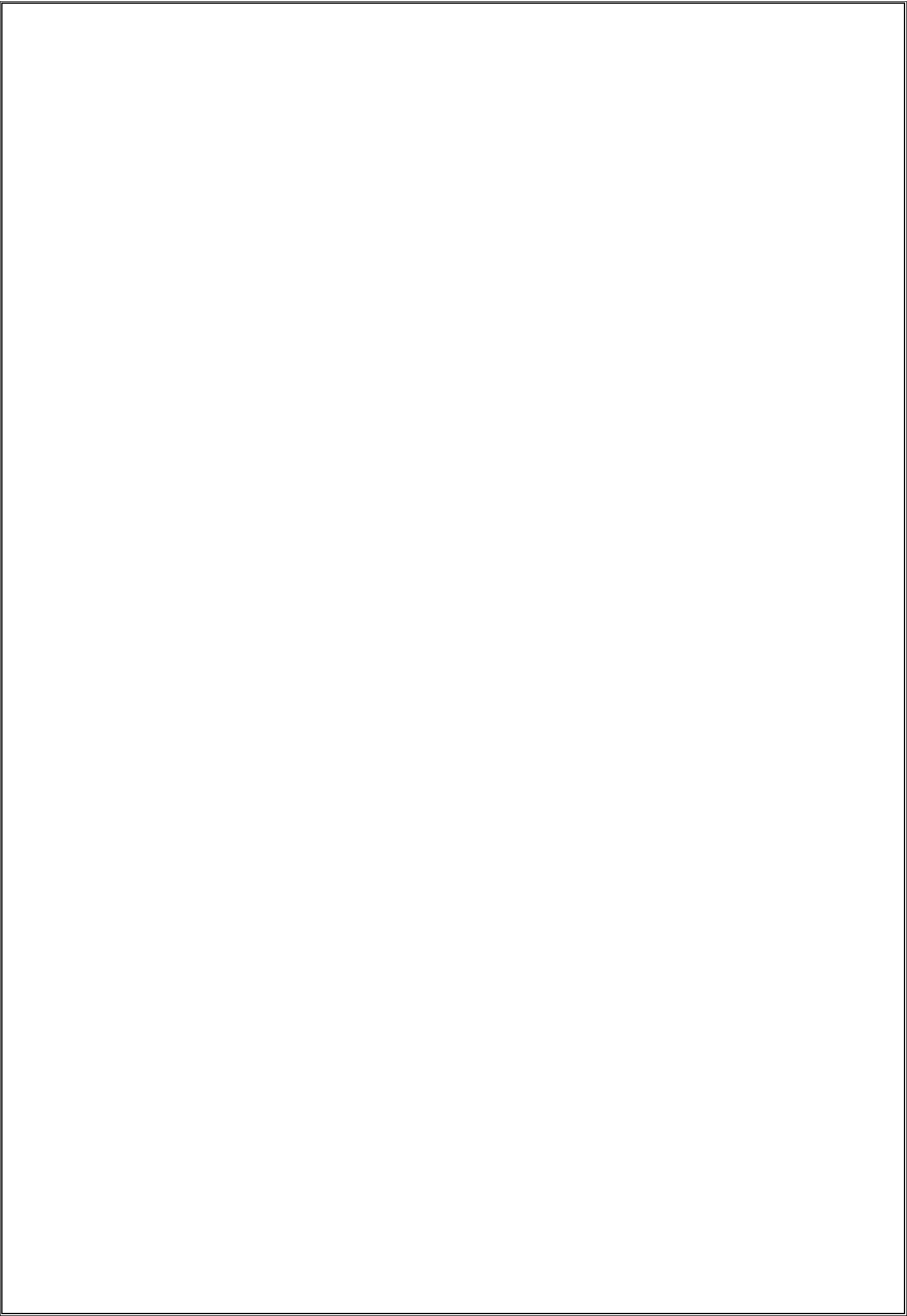

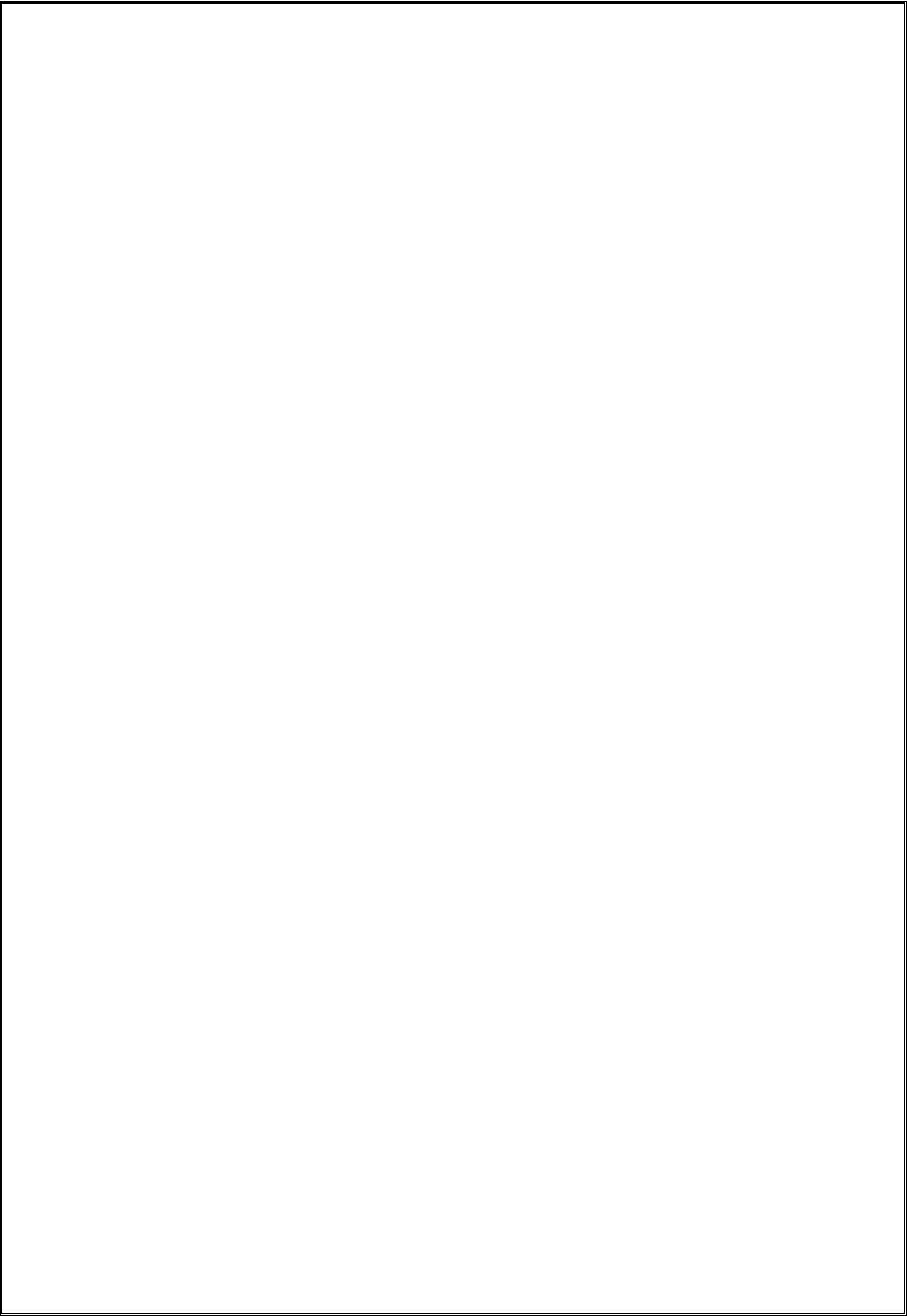
Objectives:

Challenging issues :

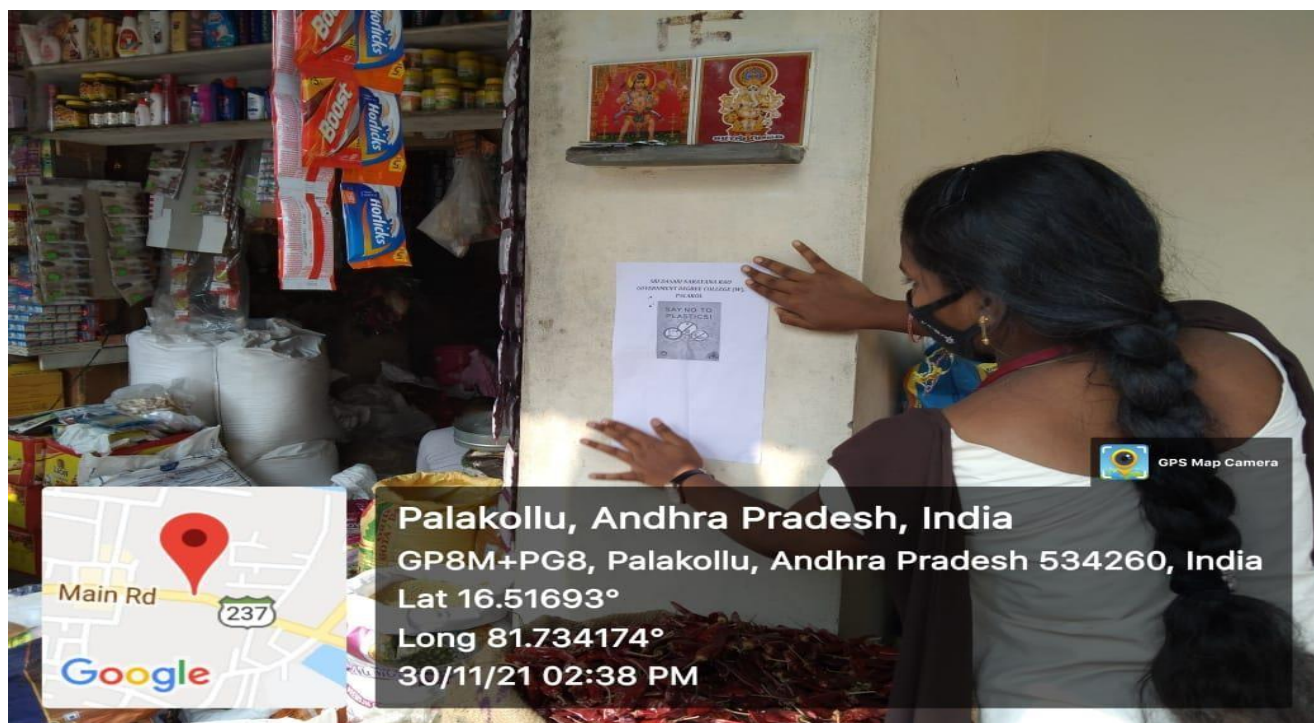
- Difficult to motivate rural household, as it was quoted --old habit die hard.

- Socio economic conditions prevailing in rural areas.

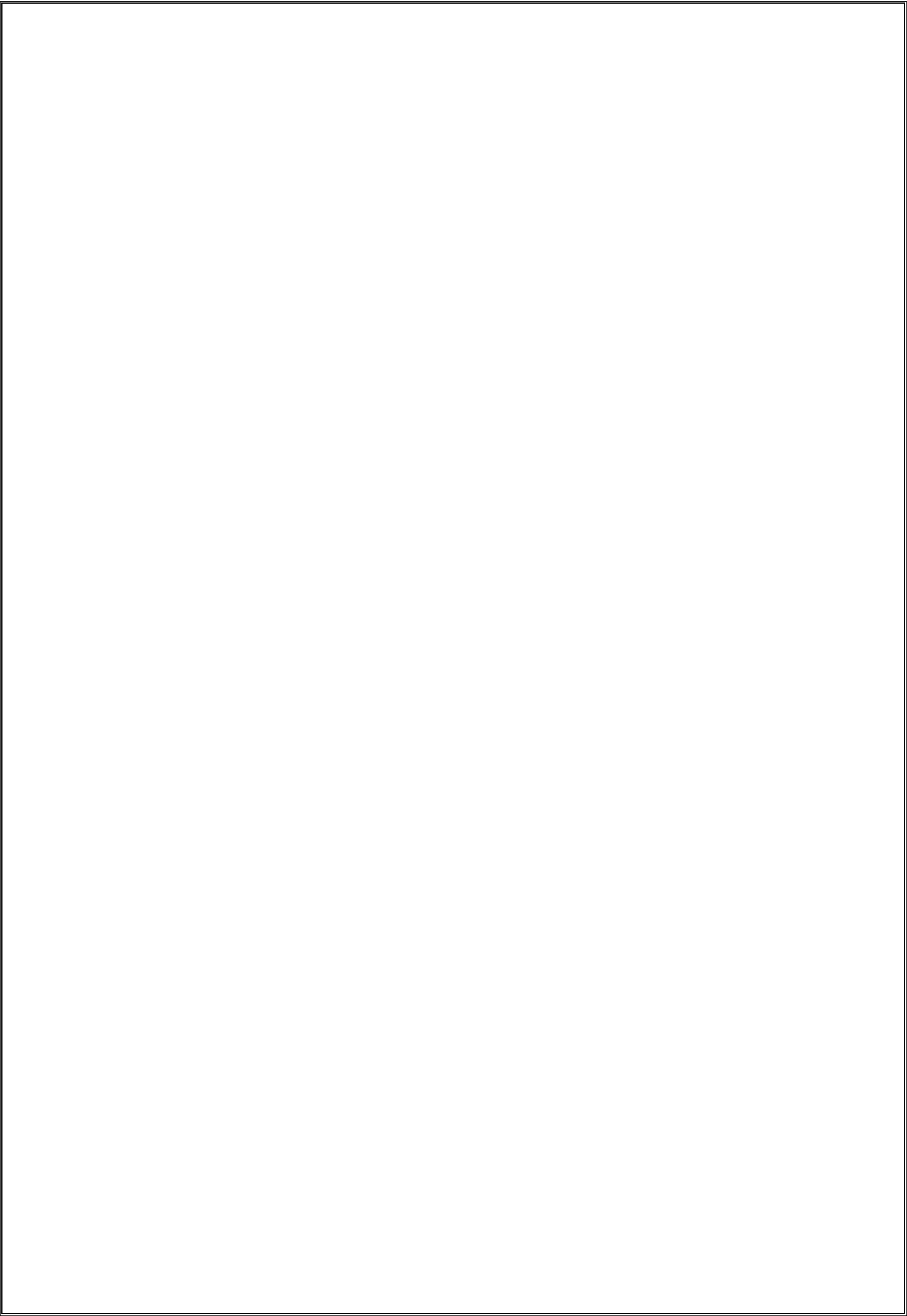
Evident of Success:

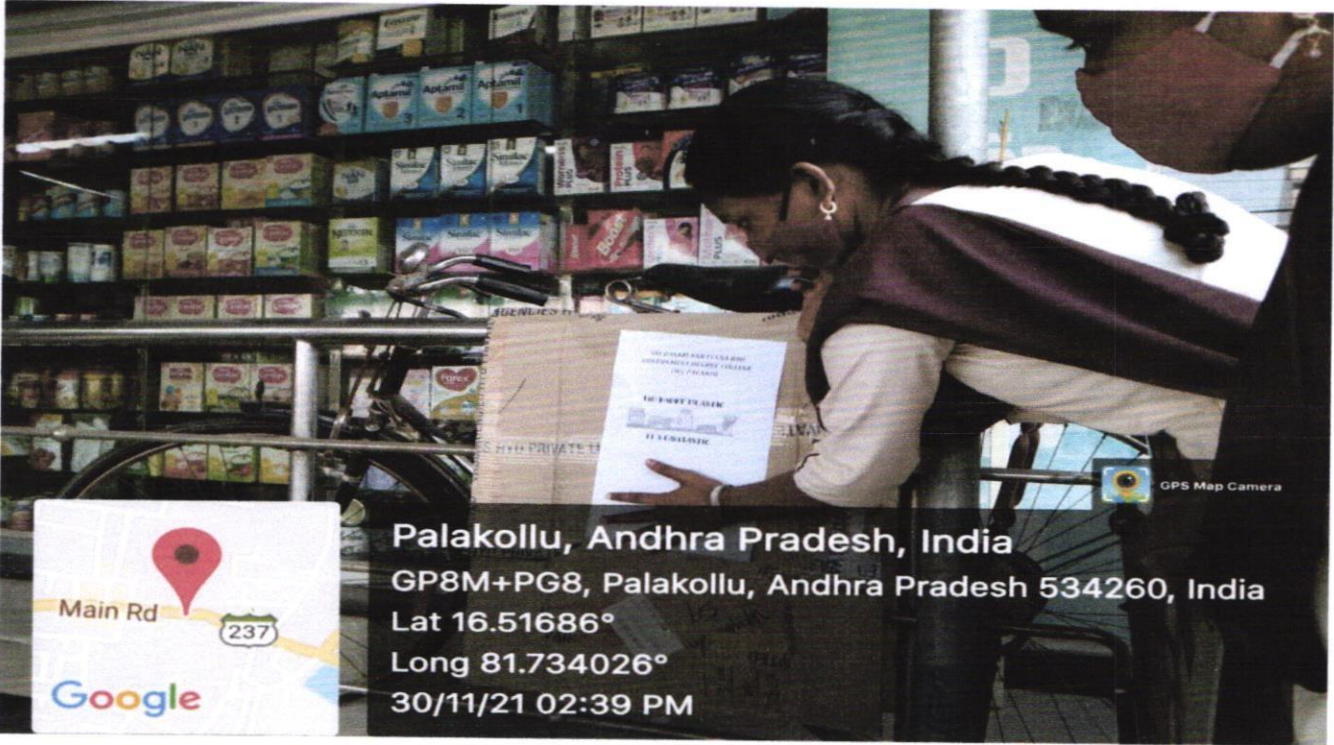
- In the premises the plastic usage was reduced.

- Wide support from NGOs and local government.



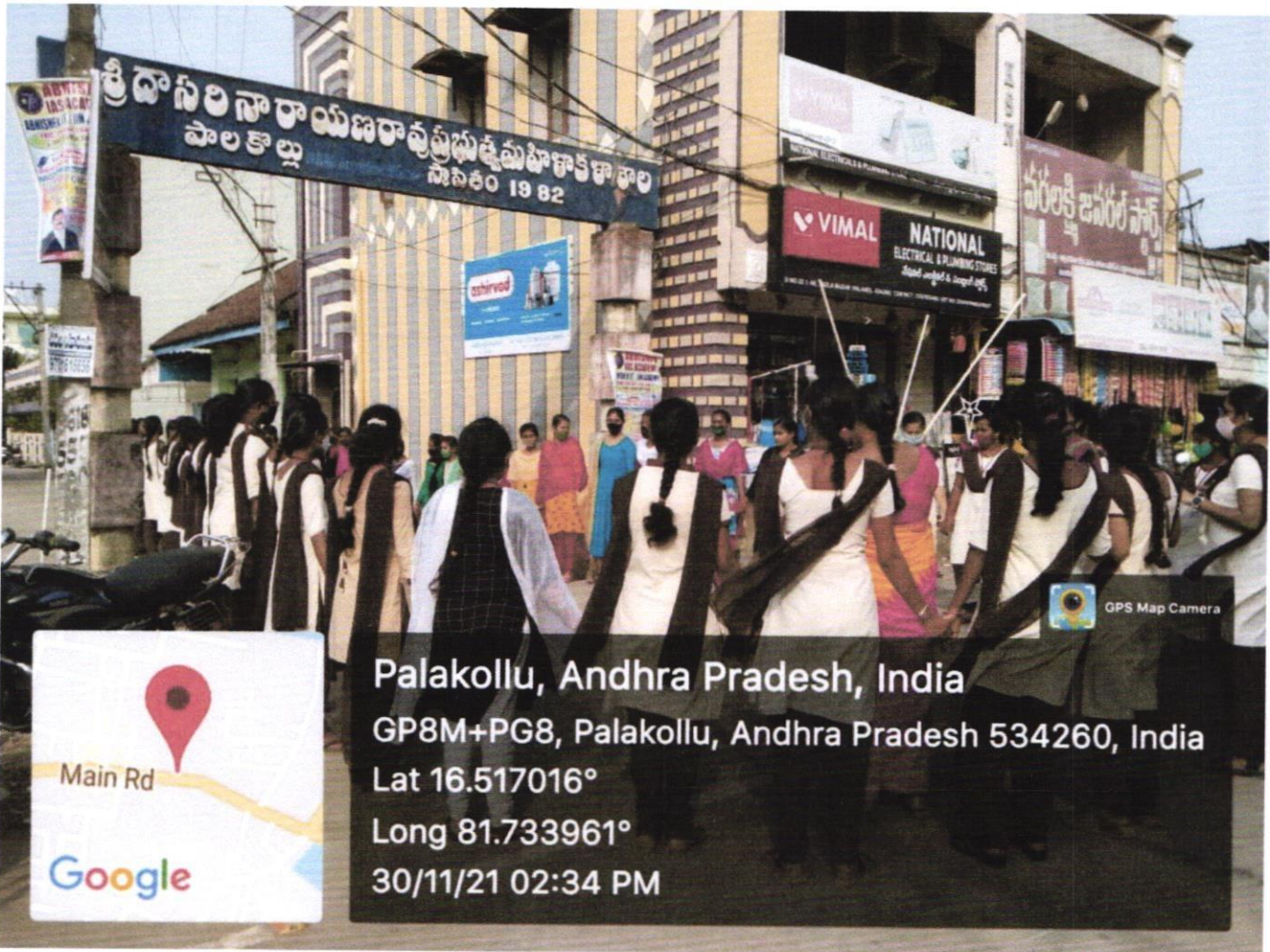




GPS Map Camera
