ORDER

The President of Sri Dasari Narayana Rao Women's College Committee have requested that a Government Degree College for Women at Palakol in West Godavari District may be started during 1982-83. The Inspection Commission appointed by the Andhra University have recommended for the starting of the Government Degree College at Palakol in West Godavari District during 1982-83 with B.A., and B.Com., Courses.

1. Government after careful examination sanction the opening of a Government Degree College for Women at Palakol in West Godavari District during 1982-83 subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions before starting of the college.

- i) The College Committee should remit an amount of Rs. 1.00 lakh towards corpus fund and another Rs. 1.50 lakhs towards one year deposit in lieu of recurring expenditure to be spent on salaries and other establishment charges, if they have not remitted these amounts so far into the Government account under the receipt head "077 - Education - E.University and other Higher Education N.H. 15. other receipts - S.H.(01) contributions and income from Endowments (to be opened)".
- ii) The College Committee should provide additional temporary accommodation exclusively for Degree Classes.
- iii) In relaxation of the condition of providing 10 acres of land imposed in G.O.No. 485 Edn., dated 24-5-82, the College Committee should provide 3 acres of land to the college as prescribed. The land given should be Registered in favour of Government.
- iv) The College Committee should construct permanent buildings to this college from their own funds within a period of 5 years at the latest.

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- v) The College Committee should provide furniture, Sci. equipment and Library books etc., as requested by the Principal within 3 months from the date of starting of the Government Degree College.
- vi) If the existing Government Junior College is to be upgraded into Government Degree College, the Junior and Degree College section shall exist separately either within the same premises or separately in which case the college committee will have to provide accommodation exclusively for the Degree College and also facilities like laboratory, library, equipment, furniture etc.,
- vii) The post of Principal of the Junior College shall continue since the Government Junior College and the Government Degree College will function independently.
- viii) The College should start with I Year (Group) B.A., and B.Com., Courses, one of the optional subjects shall be restructured course as approved by the University.
- ix) The medium of instruction should be Telugu. English Medium can also be opened provided there is a minimum strength of 30 students in the group concerned and with the prior permission of the Director of Higher Education.

3. The Government also sanction the creation of the following teaching and non-teaching staff for this Government Degree College from the date of filling up of the posts till 28-2-1983;

a) Principal	1 (One)
b) Lecturers (One each in English, Telugu, Commerce, Economics, History and Politics.	6 (Six)
c) Part-time Lecturer in Hindi	1 (One)
<u>Non-teaching Staff</u>	<u>No. of Posts</u>
a) Senior Asst. (UDC)	1 (One).
b) Jr. Asst-cum-typist (LDC cum-Typist)	1 (One)
c) Record Assistant.	1 (One)
d) Attender.	1 (One)

The above posts shall carry the usual pay and allowances admissible as per rules.

4. Sanction is also accorded for incurring non-recurring expenditure not exceeding Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) towards Office Contingencies in respect of this Government Degree College.

5. The expenditure on this college shall be met initially from the existing provision in the current year's budget and additional funds will be provided during the course of the year by enhancing the plan ceiling for 1982-83 and subsequent years. The Director of Higher Education is requested to send proposals for sanction of staff immediately.

6. The Principal, Government Degree College for Women, Palakol is permitted to incur the expenditure under contingencies and T.A.

7. The Director of Higher Education is requested to ensure that the college committee fulfills all the conditions mentioned in this order before permitting the college committee to start the classes.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance and Planning (SE) Department, vide their U.O.No.2210/DFS/(M)/82, dated 31-8-1982.
